

Boone County Public Library (BCPL) – Board of Trustees – Chapin Memorial Library Ad-Hoc Subcommittee

The Boone County Public Library - BCPL (KY) – The Chapin Memorial Library Ad Hoc Committee is tasked with overseeing the selection of a consultant and the development of a strategic rubric for the future direction of the Chapin Memorial Library. This committee will define both short-term and long-term goals to address evolving community needs and categorize the needs of the Petersburg community that can be solved by the community itself and those needs that can be supported by BCPL. The committee operates under the framework established by the BCPL Board of Trustees and aligns its recommendations with the Board's policies, the Library's procedures, and the Boone County Fiscal Court.

The Ad hoc committee is expected to report its findings and/or recommendations to the BCPL Board of Trustees within six months.

- 4. Describe your belief in the important role the Boone County Public Library plays in the community.
- 5. Describe your knowledge of the Chapin Memorial Library.
